Support to sustainable management of shared fisheries resources, SSF & prioritising inland fisheries

Support to regional aquaculture and fisheries value chains in line with the SADC Industrialisation Strategy

Promoting intra-regional fish trade through OSBP & investments in the BE sector

Building resilience and strengthening mitigation measures

Improving efforts to protect aquatic environments, including addressing issues of pollution, esp. plastic & micro-plastics pollution

Combating IUU fishing through strengthening of regional cooperation & strengthening of fisheries MCS

Mainstreaming fisheries & aquaculture into the BE

Addressing key sectoral cross-cutting BE issues (RD&I, capacity building, gender, etc.)

- Effective fisheries monitoring control and surveillance (MCS), including operationalization of the SADC Fisheries Monitoring Control and Surveillance Coordination Centre (MCSCC) (<u>11 MS ratified</u>)
- Programme for Improving Fisheries Governance and Blue Economy Trade Corridors in SADC Region (PROFISHBLUE Project) (7 ADF MS, regional impact)
- Coordinated implementation of tools to tackle issues related to safety, labour and illegal, unreported, and unregulated (IUU) fishing in SADC region
- Implementation of the SADC Blue Economy Strategy and Action Plan (2023-2032) (<u>8 MS domesticating</u>)





- Building Climate Resilience and Adaptive Capacities in Small-Scale Fisheries and Aquaculture in Southern Africa
- Promoting Regional Market Clusters and Competitive Fish Value Chains in SADC region
- Promoting Private Sector & SMEs Investment Support in the SADC Fisheries and Aquaculture Value Chains
- Support joint fisheries assessments and vessel frame surveys (riparian systems)

- Piloting of MCS tolls in inland fisheries
