




















#### The Nile Basin

- Longest River, 6695km
- •Basin Area: 3.2 million sq.km, 10% of Africa;
- Basin covers 11 Basin countries
- Population of over 550 million; 272 mill. in the basin
- Low runoff coefficient for most regions (approx. 0.2)
- Endowed with rich natural and environmental assets
- Rich historical heritage






- Established on February 22, 1999, by Ministers in charge of Water Affairs in the Nile Basin countries.
- The Shared Vision Objective: "To achieve sustainable social economic development through the equitable utilization of, and benefit from, the common Nile Basin Water resources"



### Nile Basin Cooperative Framework Agreement (CFA)

- Entry into force 13 Oct 2024
- Ratified by 6 Riparian States.
  Process underway in remaining States
- New era of Nile cooperation based on IWL principles e.g.
  - duty to cooperate,
  - equitable and reasonable use,
  - no-significant harm, etc.
- Establishes legal basis the Nile River Basin Commission (NRBC)to replace the NBI
- Operationalization of NRBC


