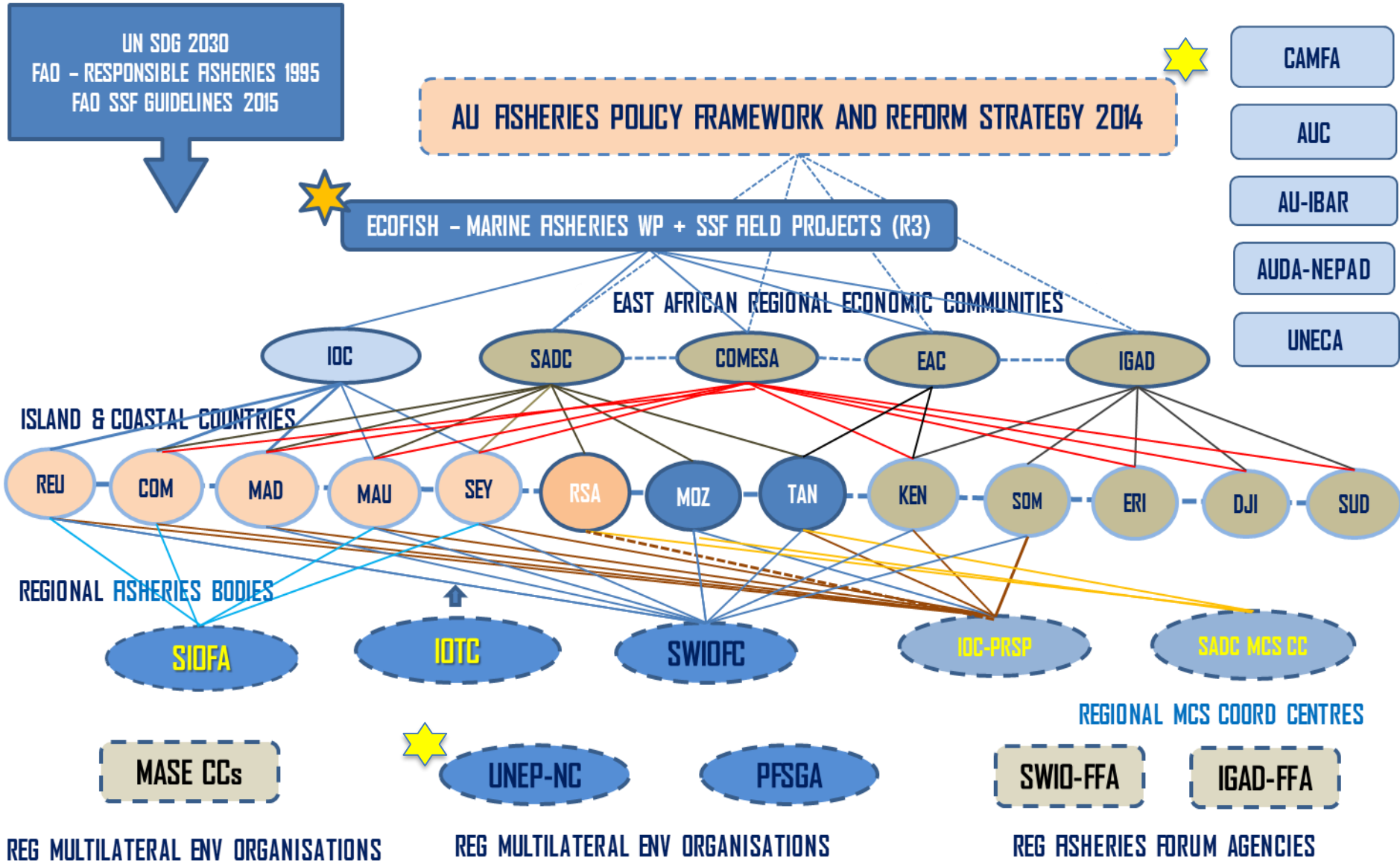


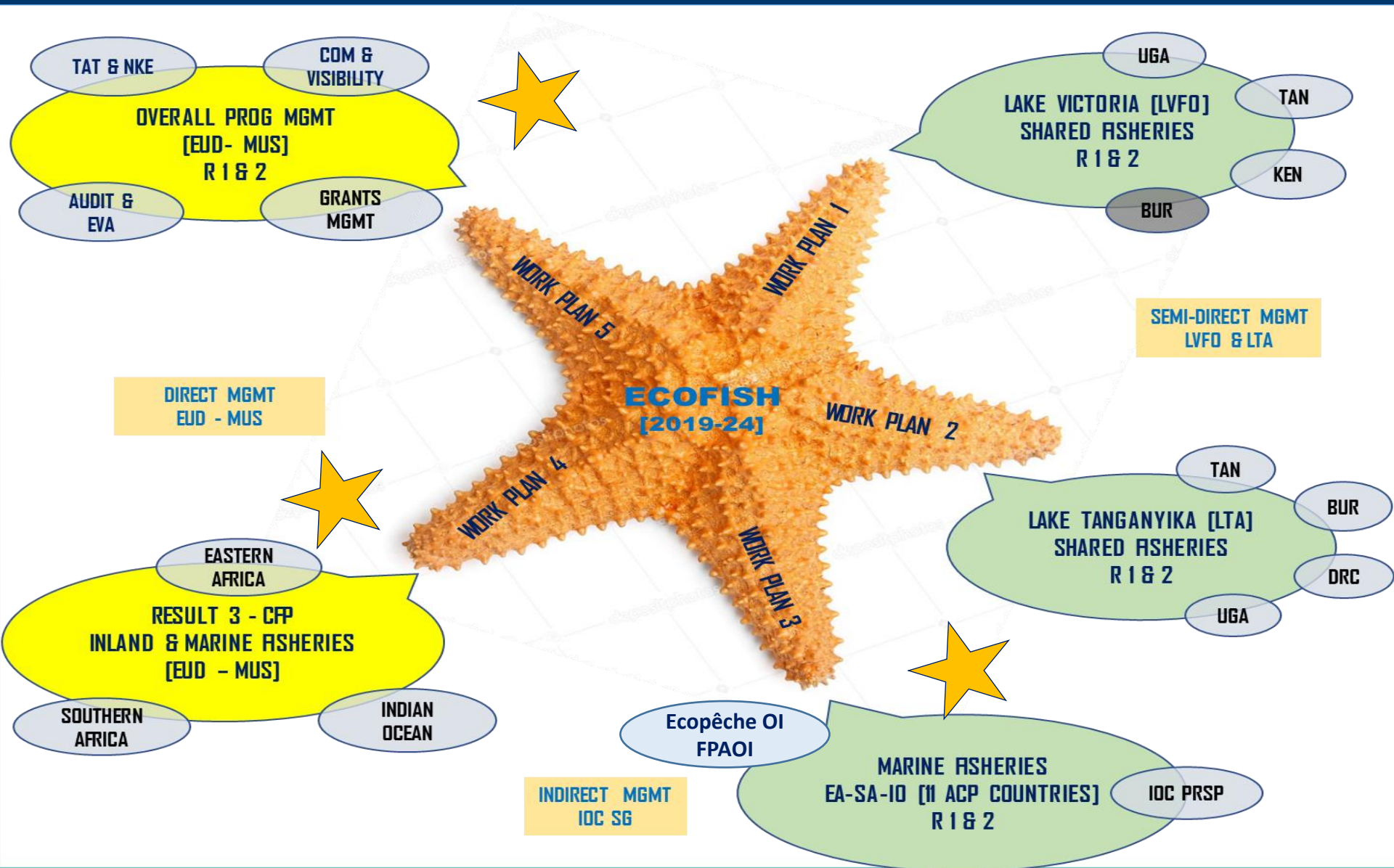
BLUEING THE INLAND & MARINE FISHERIES IN EA-SA-10



The landscape of the EA-SA-IO CAPTURE FISHERIES







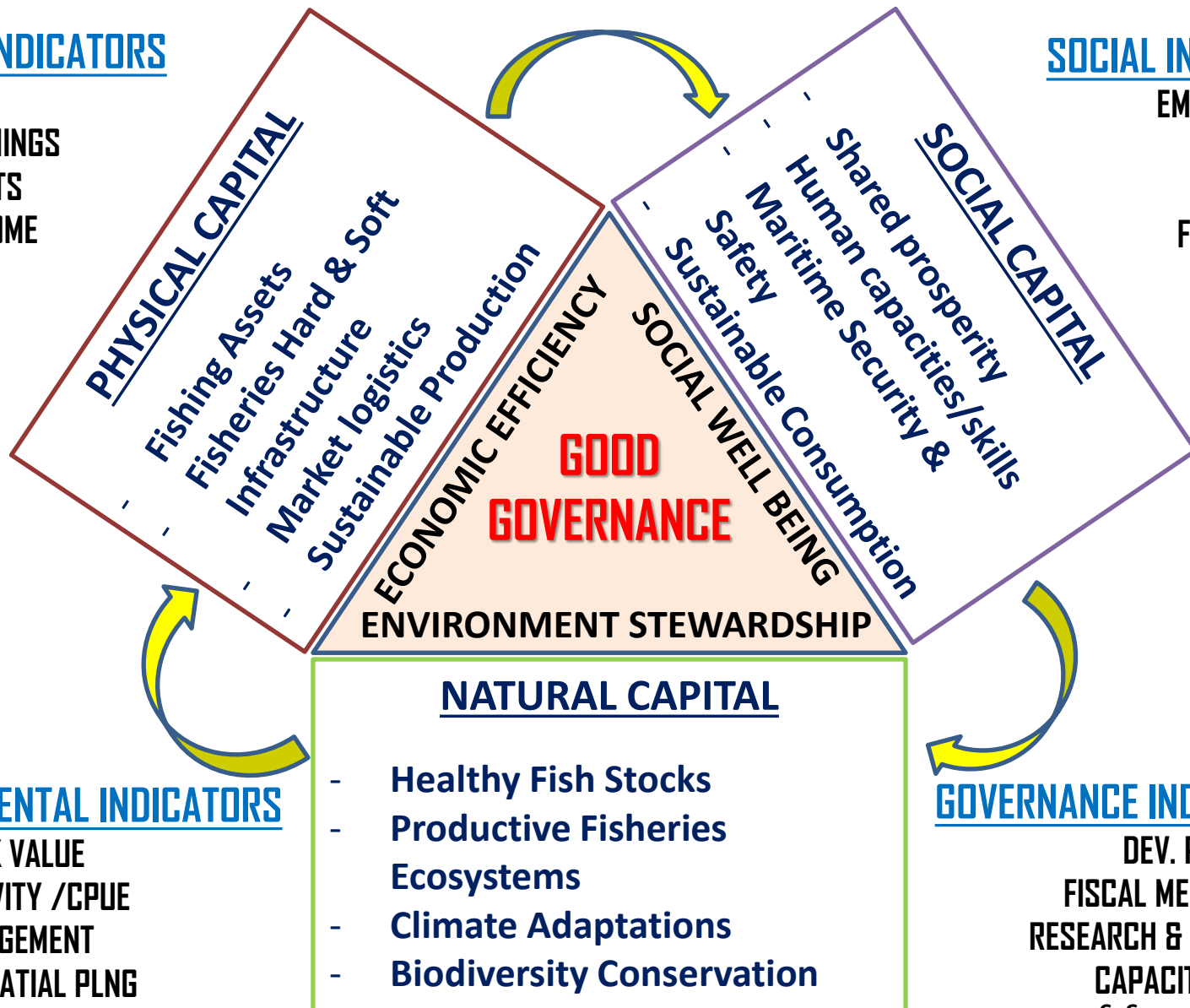
