#### **COMESA's Vision**


 The Vision of COMESA is, "To have a fully integrated internationally competitive regional economic community with high standards of living for its entire people, ready to merge into the African Economic Community".

## Strategic Objective 1: To enhance Livestock and Fisheries Production and Animal Health to increase productivity and resilience of production systems

- ❖ Regional Enterprise Competitiveness and Access to Markets Programme (RECAMP) Support to Dairy, Meat, Poultry and Fisheries industries
- ❖ Small Scale Cross-Border Trade Initiative (SSCBTI): facilitate small scale cross-border traders at selected border posts indirectly supporting production/health
- Supporting member states in the development and harmonization of policies, strategies and veterinary legislations in partner with AU-IBAR, WOAH, FAO
- ❖ Developed Regional Emergency Preparedness and Contingency plan; Supporting the use of Pastoralist Indigenous Knowledge and best practices with AU-SAFGRAD
- ❖ ECOFISH Project: Sustainable Fisheries Development, support member states in enhancing production and conservation. 6 COMESA member states (Kenya, Sudan, Mauritius, Zambia, Madagascar) are being supported in enhancing small scale fisheries- We have developed Blue Economy Fisheries Satellite Account
- ❖ FISH-GOV II: Sustainable Fisheries, Aquaculture and Blue Economy development: implementation of AFRM, we are member of Africa Platform for Regional Institutions in Fisheries and Aquaculture and Aquatic Systems (APRIFAAS)- we have developed a number of policy instruments, reviewed international instruments
- ❖ FISH-GOV II: supported a number of experience sharing visits-aquaculture development is encouraging









# Strategic Objective 2: To enhance access to markets, services and value addition

- ❖ Regional Enterprise Competitiveness and Access to Markets Programme (RECAMP) FED/2019/407-838- Agro-processing (Dairy, Meat, Poultry and Fisheries)
- Support member states in enhancing value chain, value addition and trade in animal and animal source foods; support MS in enhancing animal resources value chain
- Support Member States access to markets, services and value addition- working with CBC, USAID RDOAG
- ❖ Small Scale Cross-Border Trade Initiative (SSCBTI): facilitate small scale cross-border traders at selected border posts – the use of STR

## Strategic Objective 3: Improve animal health systems and reduce impact of animal diseases on livestock production, productivity and public health

- ❖ COMESA is working with AU-IBAR, World Organization for Animal Health (WOAH) on enhancing animal health system through sharing of information on TADs. We are also supporting MS on PVS
- ❖ COMESA is partnering with AU-IBAR and has supported the development of continental animal health strategy for Africa, we supported in updating veterinary legislations and animal health regulations, training on aquatic animal health
- ❖ COMESA is member of WOAH CBPP standing group of experts; WOAH supported Regional Training of Focal Points for Aquatic Animal Health, Aquatic animal diseases network
- ❖ To support Animal Resources Small Scale Cross Border Trade Initiative there is a plan to work with WOAH on SPS in southern Africa
- ❖ COMESA Support Towards Regional Pharmaceutical Sector Development, institutional support for the development of the **pharmaceutical industry** through strengthened capacities of the region's pharmaceutical **regulatory bodies**, **quality control and management** systems and **research**
- ❖ We partner on Antimicrobial Resistance and also one health initiatives of AU CDC and WOAH
- ❖ Currently there is an ongoing activity to control and eradicate Peste des Petitis Ruminantis (PPR) and major respiratory diseases of small ruminants- though not directly involved whenever our professional inputs are required, we take part.

Strategic Objective 4: Enhance Blue Economy in COMESA for an inclusive and sustainable ecosystem management and for livelihood diversification

- ❖ Institutionalization of a functional Blue Economy at COMESA and its Member States
- Improve the health of marine and aquatic ecosystems and protect loss of biodiversity by promoting the mitigation measures
- ❖ Support research and promote innovative Blue Economy Enhancing technologies we are working with Ocean Hub Africa (OHA) –
- COMESA in partnership with AUC-AU-IBAR has been working on Blue Economy, conservation and better utilization of Natural Resources
  - COMESA Blue Economy Strategy (AU-IBAR)
  - Eswatini, Malawi, Zambia Blue Economy Strategy with support of AUC
- ❖ We work with OHA: -Ocean Innovation Africa is Africa's first and foremost Blue Economy summit, aiming to catalyse sustainable, equitable development of the African ocean economy














### **Impact: Trade**




COMESA Exports of meat and edible meat offal within the region, to the rest of Africa and to the rest of the world







## COMESA Exports of Poultry and Poultry product within the region, to the rest of Africa and to the ROW




# COMESA Trade Facilitation Instruments

- Removal of non-tariff barriers (NTBs), lowering of trading costs at borders, improving trade infrastructure and automation of customs and transit systems, which include:
- The Digital Free Trade Area comprising e-commerce, e-regulations and e-logistics. regulations for the implementation of the COMESA electronic Certificate of Origin it is under piloting of the system. (8 countries are under pilot-Malawi, Zambia and Eswatini are in progress) Ethiopia, Djibouti, Kenya, Zimbabwe and Seychelles are also in good progress
- System of reporting of NTBs developed and is being used in a bid to facilitate trade and ease of doing business across borders
- Small-Scale Cross Border Trade: the use of Simplified Trade Regime (STR). The STR aims to reduce costs and increases the speed of crossing the border by use of a Simplified Customs Document (SCD) as well as simplified customs clearance procedures
- The Regional Customs Transit Guarantee Scheme (RCTG) developed and has Mobile Application which is accessible on Google Play Store and Apple Store to Clearing and Forwarding Agents
- Guidelines to facilitate movement of essential goods and services developed
